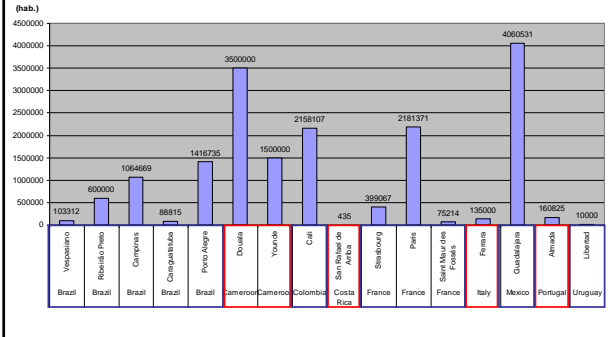

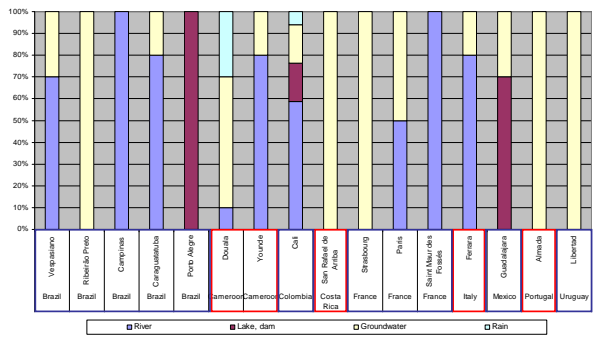

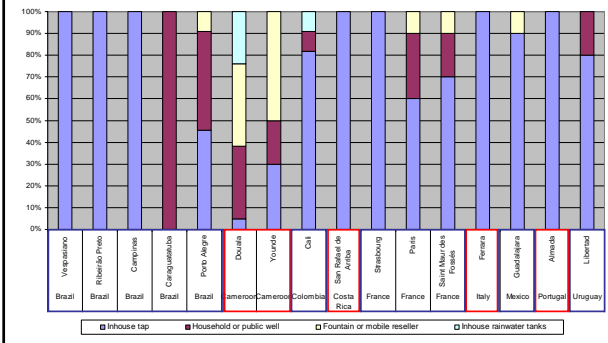
City population

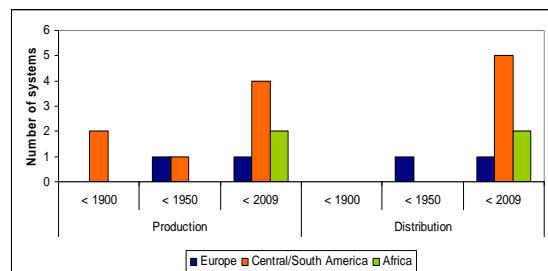
Drinkable-water distribution type

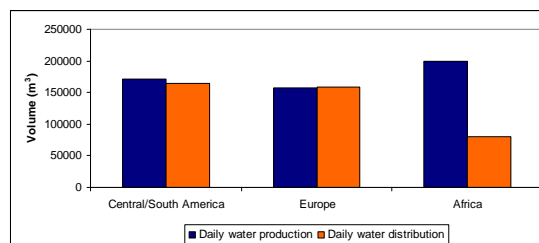

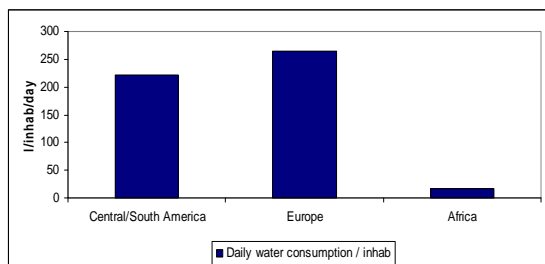
Is all water produced distributed to the consumer?

- Relação entre produção e distribuição de água



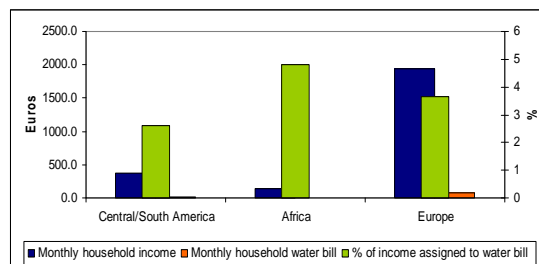
How much water per inhabitant?

- Consumo de água



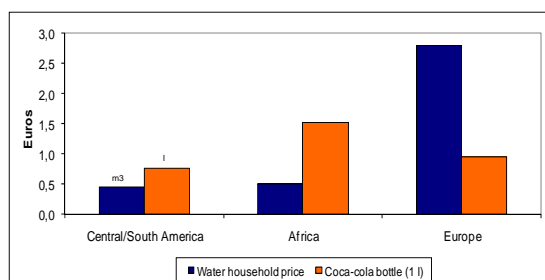
How expensive is water?

- Preço da água

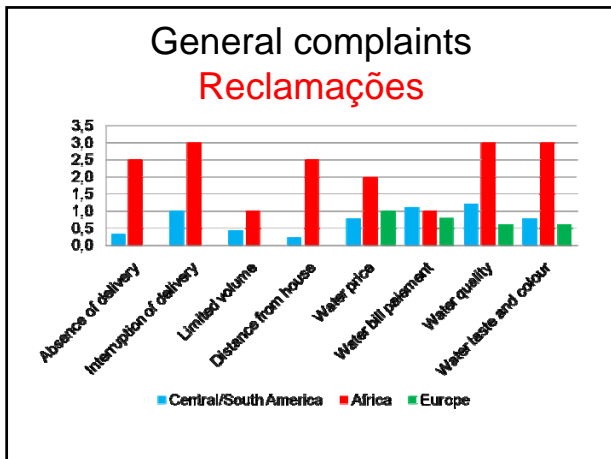

- **Water production and /or distribution should be:**
 - ✓ Private (15%) ⇒ Transparency in management
 - ✓ Public (85%) ⇒ Social equity
- **Citizens should be involved in the water management**
 - ✓ User committee;
 - ✓ Management Council;
 - ✓ Consumer organisation;
 - ✓ Elected representatives;
 - ✓ Non Governmental Organisations (NGO).

- **Should drinking water be for free:**
 - ✓ No (40%) ⇒ for everyone ;
 - ✓ Yes (60%) ⇒ depending on the household income/ the consume volume of water per household.
